

St George's Stamford - Curacy 2024

St George's Stamford is looking for a new curate to join our team in the summer of 2024. We are an evangelical charismatic church with good links to both New Wine and Keswick. We place a high value on preaching, prayer, mission, and church revitalisation.

We meet in three Sunday congregations (9:15, 11am and 6:30pm) with 40 mid-week small groups, lively children's and youth ministry, a great staff team of fifteen people and a commitment to social action. We are committed to supporting both women and men in ministry training. St George's is great place to train in a loving and supportive church family.

Stamford is a beautiful Georgian market town of 20,000 people, one and a half hours north of London on the A1 and one hour west of Cambridge. The nearest city is Peterborough with fast trains (50 minutes) to London. The deanery of which Martyn Taylor is the rural dean, includes all the traditions of the Church of England including a village group on the edge of town.

We are a 'Resource Church' in Lincoln Diocese having recently planted into Spalding and Grantham. As a training incumbent Martyn Taylor has mentored three curates, who have all gone on to find incumbent posts in Lincoln Diocese. Our clergy team includes an experienced Associate Rector who is an excellent colleague.

As a resource church our calling is to revitalise other market town churches in partnership with the diocese. This may be a fit for our next curate, but ultimately, we are looking for the person that God is calling as curate to St George's. Might that be you?

St George's provides an excellent context for training in a larger church context with a staff team. We want to help you grow in personal spiritual formation, the handling and teaching of the scriptures, the work of an evangelist and pastoral care, as well as help you navigate the training requirements that the diocese require of you.

Are you a person of faith who believes that the Lord can do more than we can imagine? Are you humble, teachable, gracious, and secure in your own faith? Are you willing to do the work of an evangelist and handle God's word faithfully in an engaging manner? Do you have leadership gifts with evidence of growing and leading teams in your ministry experience so far?

We are looking for someone who feels excited that the Lord might be calling them to serve and train at St George's Stamford and open to where that might lead.
